- 3 **Minutes of the last meeting** – All agreed, DW signed and dated
- 4 **Matters Arising from the Minutes**
- a. Points of interest leaflet– JS still working on this **Action: JS**
  - b. Dog Waste Bin at Holly Hill – another step now added, however, one is now cracked, JH said RH would sort it out **Action: JH**
  - c. New Playing Field Equipment – nothing to date **Action: HK**
  - d. Overflow at bottom of Well Hall Farm Yard – JH read out an email regarding this. New drains put in at the far side of the buildings, path between the two footpath gates at the bottom of the yard extremely boggy and muddy, suggested hardcore to go down and also suggested that JH go back to the Environment agency re this **Action: JH**
